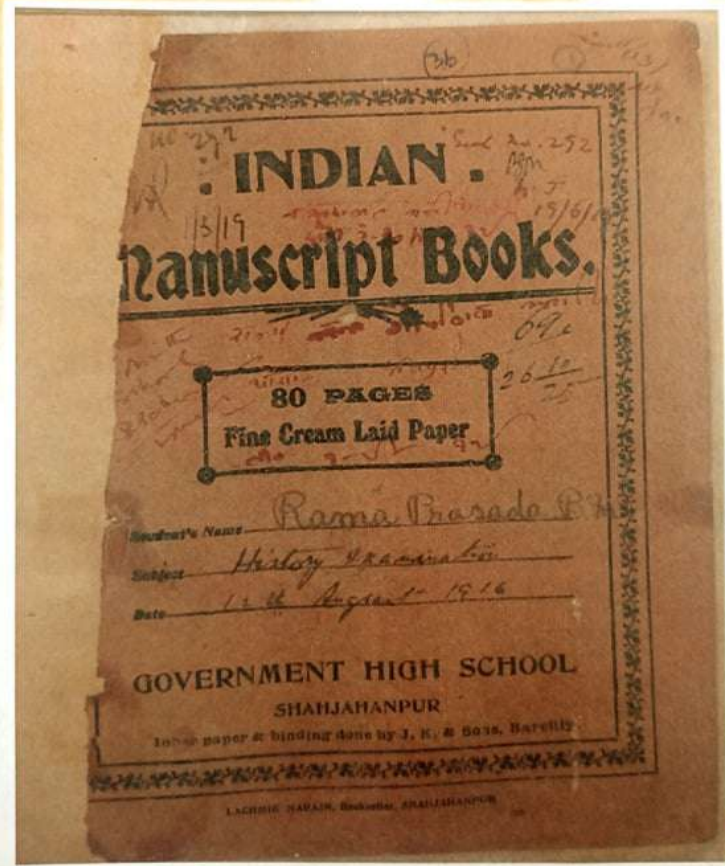

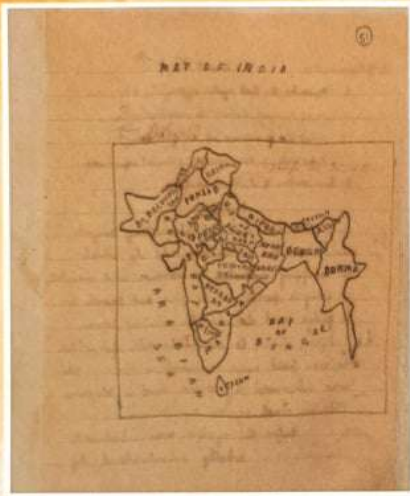

The old system of administering Bengal was introduced in the year 1765 by which the Company collected the revenue and made it easy to collect the revenue and land was to judge and decide the criminal cases and they were to maintain order for which he was paid some amount of money. This was introduced by Alivardi and in 1765 Charles Cornwallis introduced the new system before the system was introduced Bengal was wholly administered by

the British, who took away half from the Company and paid the other half to the British and their expenses. The British took the salt tax as the British as the people were very much benefited.

4. Salt duty - being taken in Europe, China and other interesting nations is called salt duty.

5. Land Revenue in India with the Royal British Charter is for the protection of British against enemies that may come from across the sea. The other duties are to remove thieves and robbers, to guard harbours, to prevent piracy to protect ships and to carry out revenue.

Salt monopoly is government monopoly and is based on the fact that the salt and potash are the commodities of salt is used in the production of dyestuffs, sulphuric acid, gunpowder, etc. Home charges - These are expenses incurred in England itself on account of the salary of the British officers including the Secretary of State for India and his Council members, who are appointed in the office of India.
